Quick configuration guide

- 1 **Connect to N-vio** (see the connection section [N-vio](#) or [N-vio Lite](#))
- 2 **Login:** use the username and password that appear on your standard configuration sheet. Select “Campaign Manager” in the Home screen to start.

- 3 **Go to “Files”.**

Click on “Browse” to find the file you wish to send on your computer. Once selected, click on “Upload” and your file will be uploaded.

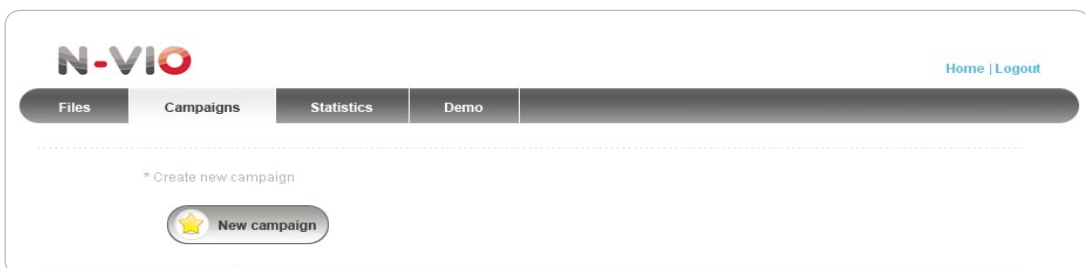


- 4 **Creating a campaign**

Go to “Campaigns”

Select “New campaign”.

Enter the name and logo you wish (this data is for easier viewing only and will not appear in the message for sending) and click on “Create”. The created campaign will appear.

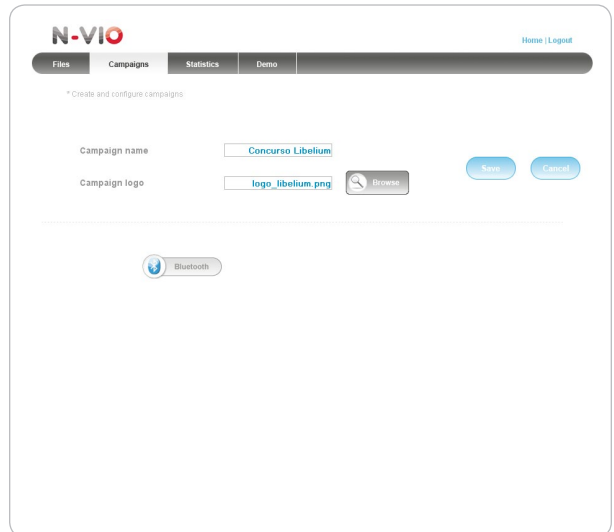
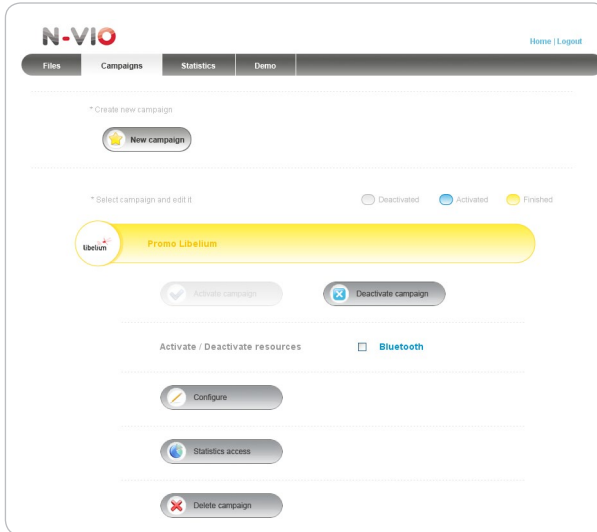

5 Configuring the campaign resource

Click on your campaign and select “Configure” from the dropdown menu. Click on “Bluetooth” to start configuring.

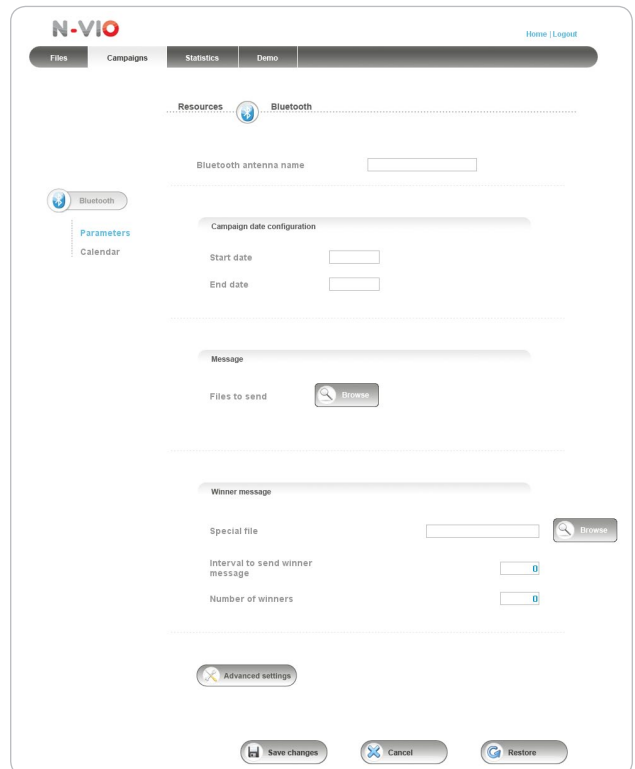


Configuring settings

Enter the Name of the Bluetooth antenna (this name will appear when the message is sent depending on the model of telephone). Select the start and end dates of your campaign.

Click on “Browse” and select the files you wish to send. Only selected files will be sent.

Click on “Save changes” before moving on to configure the calendar.

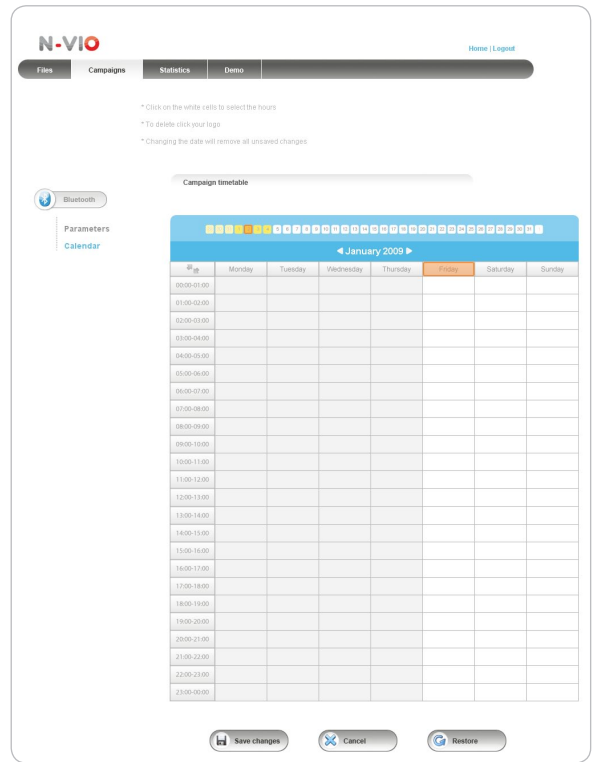

Calendar configuration

Select “Calendar” from the side menu. The times table appears highlighted by default from the campaign start date.

Select the times at which you want the message to be sent by clicking on the table’s cell. You can select entire rows or columns by clicking on the time or day cell and also select the entire table by clicking on the arrows icon.

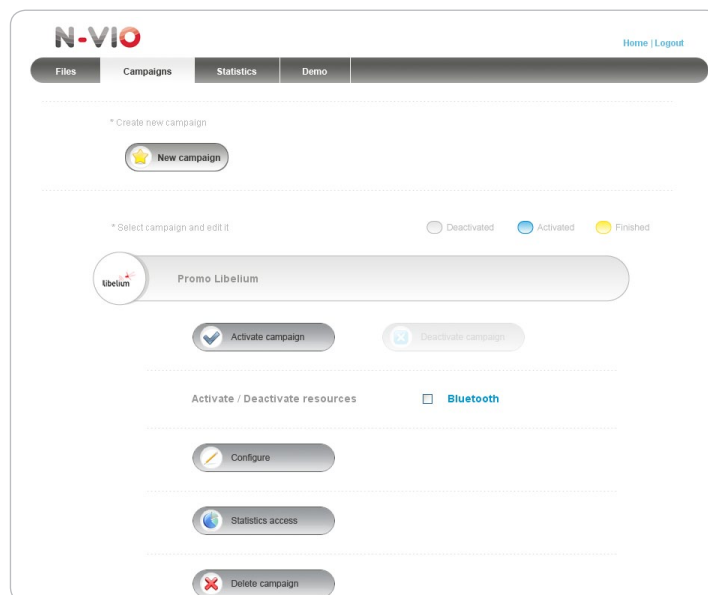
Click on the days in order to change the week to be edited and when you have finished click on “Save changes”.



6 Resource and campaign activation.

The resource and the campaign must be enabled for the messages to be sent. To do so, go to “Campaigns”, click on your campaign and select “Activate campaign” and “Bluetooth” from the dropdown menu.

Your campaign is now ready to operate.
